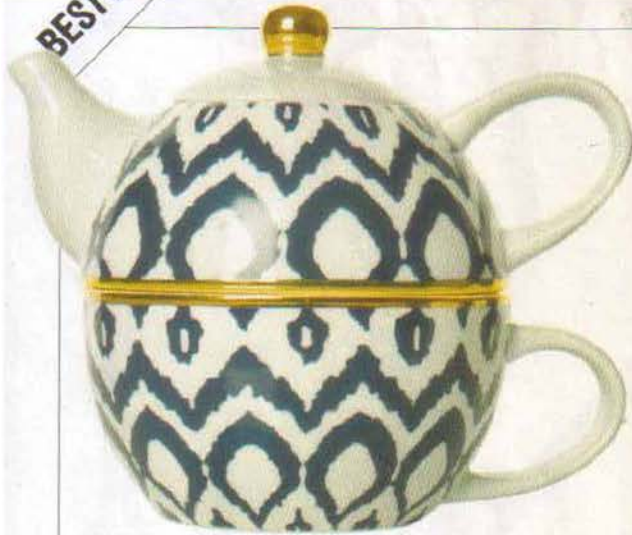


**BEST BETS**

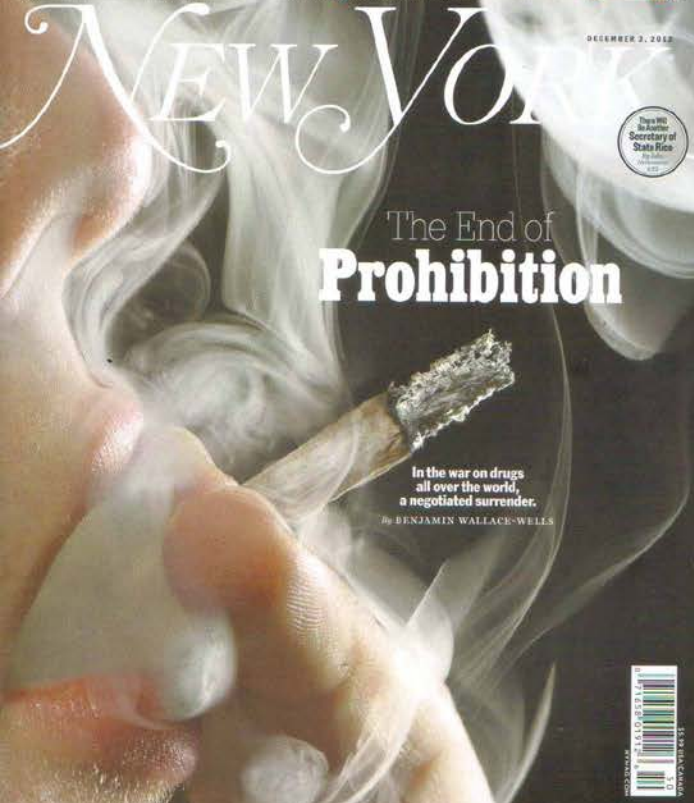
